Tenaska Marketing Ventures

- Among the five largest natural gas marketers in North America since 2013
- Sold or managed 10.7 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas per day in 2019, a volume equal to 10% of the total U.S./Canadian gas demand
- Ranks first among marketers in natural gas pipeline capacity trading since 2009
- Geographical area covers all of the North America, transporting natural gas on every major pipeline system
- Manages 14.5 Bcf of natural gas storage and is the exclusive natural gas fuel supplier/ manager for 2,500 MW of electric generation in Texas

The Paris Cogeneration Station near Paris, Texas, was the first power plant constructed by Tenaska. It began commercial operation in 1989.

Current Generating Capacity: 3,000 megawatts (MW), meeting the needs of 3 million Texas homes

Technical Innovation: Tenaska's Frontier and Gateway plants nationally acclaimed for serving both Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT) and adjacent transmission grid

Tax Revenue: In 2019, approximately \$4.3 million in property taxes at the power plants, of which \$3 million supported local school districts; \$1 million in franchise taxes and regulatory assessments at Tenaska, its marketing affiliates and its power plants

Employment: More than 350 total Texas employees at power plants and regional offices

Economic Impact: Annual employee wages and vendor payments total \$367 million at Tenaska's regional offices and plant locations

Committed Citizenship: Tenaska and its customers contributed more than \$285,000 in scholarships to over 300 college-bound students in Texas since 2000; employees are active community members, volunteering for civic and educational programs

Tenaska Investment in Texas

New power plant development has been Tenaska's core function since the company's founding in 1987, and Texas has played a big role. Tenaska has developed 19 generating facilities, including its very first in Paris, Texas. Tenaska went on to build four more plants in the great state of Texas, with two still owned and operated by Tenaska affiliates. A plant in Oklahoma also supplies power to Texas' ERCOT market.



Shiro, Texas



- 830-MW, natural gas-fueled power plant near Shiro began commercial operation in 2000
- Owned by Tenaska Frontier Partners, Ltd.; produces energy for Exelon Generation Company, LLC
- 28 full-time employees and local contractors and vendors earn more than \$5 million annually
- Since 2000 has paid more than \$50.6 million in property
- Voluntary Protection Program Star Worksite, the nation's highest safety designation



Mr. Enterprise, Texas

Tenaska Gateway Generating Station

- 845-MW, natural gas-fueled power plant near Mt. Enterprise began commercial operation in 2001
- Owned by Tenaska Gateway Partners, Ltd.; produces energy for Shell Energy North America (US), L.P.
- 28 full-time employees and local contractors and vendors earn approximately \$7.6 million annually
- Since 2001 has paid approximately \$40.5 million in property
- Voluntary Protection Program Star Worksite, the nation's highest safety designation
